

Provider Access Policy Statement 2022

In accordance with the Technical and Further Education Act 2017 and s.42B of the Education Act 1997, the NCS ensures that there is an opportunity for a range of education and training providers to access students for the purposes of informing them about approved technical education qualifications and apprenticeships, whether through assemblies, the Emerging Talent Programme, our career events and other available workshops.

Providers seeking to access our students in order to inform them of approved technical education qualifications under Section A2DA of the Apprenticeships, Skills, Children and Learning Act 2009, should contact our SLT lead for Careers, Information, Advice and Guidance (CIAG) via enquiries@sixthform.london/

The request will be considered by the SLT responsible for CIAG and the Principal who will grant access where the request:

- Is from an Ofsted registered 16-19 provider; and
- Does not impact negatively on the existing educational provision for students.

Once approved, the SLT lead for CIAG will work with the provider to identify the best method for accessing our student body. Where possible, NCS will make the lecture theatre, classrooms and other learning spaces available to host discussions between providers and students.

Providers are welcome to leave a copy of their prospectus or other relevant course literature at our receptions. These will be made available to students within our Learning Resource Centre (LRC) which has a dedicated careers area. The LRC is available to all students throughout the Sixth Form day.
